Subject: School Uniform Policy -Reg.

Dear Parents,

This policy has been introduced by the School to make students who attend STEM School easily identifiable, that also be a safety issue when travelling to and from school and on school trips.

Purpose to make school clothing compulsory so that pupils:

- ❖ Foster pride and belonging
- ❖ Easily identify STEM School students (safety consideration)
- ❖ Eliminate dress competition among students and promote equality.

Guidelines

- ❖ This policy will take effect from **June 23, 2025**.
- ❖ **90 % of Uniforms are already distributed.**
- ❖ The school expects all pupils to wear the designated school uniform.
- ❖ **The Regular uniform to be worn from Monday to Friday and Sports Uniform to be worn on designated sports days (When sports periods are scheduled) and in addition to this all students are required to wear sports uniform every Saturday.**

The School Uniform shall consist of the following items and combination to be worn, are as follows:

Class-K1 to II
(Boys-Regular)

(Class K1 to V)

(Boys-Regular)

(Boys- Regular)

Uniform Shoes
Class K1 to X (All)



Hair ties/ribbons/bands – One ponytail/ plait with black/grey colour ribbon.

If a student is not in the school uniform, parents are asked to meet the Principal explaining the reason. Each request will be treated on case by case basis. If a student is consistently out of uniform, appropriate procedures will be upheld.

The Class Teacher has the discretion to deal with these problems on an individual basis or refer them to the Principal for discussion.

NOTE: Parents, please ensure your child wears their sports uniform on days when they have scheduled games periods.

Uniform shoes must be the same brand and model as specified by the school; that's Plaeto.
